- Review privacy and chat permissions
- Discuss online safety expectations
- Decide which features should be enabled

Shared Account Management

Roblox should not be used in secret. Parents should keep access to account settings, messages, and friends lists.

Where to Find Key Safety Controls

Chat & Messaging

Settings → Privacy

- Restrict who can chat and message

Friend Requests

Settings → Privacy

- Limit who can send requests

Account PIN

Settings → Security

- Enable PIN for changes

Parental Controls

Settings → Parental Controls

- Monthly spend limits
- Content restrictions

Menu names may change as platforms update. Review settings together regularly.
